AUSTRALIAN DRIVERS' CHAMPIONSHIP

First awarded in 1957, the Australian Drivers' Championship for the Motorsport Australia Gold Star medal is Australia's oldest and most prestigious drivers' award. It is reserved for the premier open wheel formula in the nation.

TELEVISION COVERAGE

S5000 races at SpeedSeries events will be televised live and ad-free on Stan Sport, supported by free-to-air live coverage (Race 1 on Saturdays) on 9Gem, plus post-event highlights on an HD channel of the Nine Network.

Races supporting rounds of the Supercars Championship will be televised on Fox Sports and Kayo with the possibility of races from selected events being simulcast free-to-air on the Seven Network, specifically - the Gold Coast 500 and Adelaide 500.

ENGINES

Each engine is individually dyno-tested and set up by engine suppliers InnoV8 prior to delivery. Performance is monitored throughout racing by InnoV8 via its exclusive access to the engine ECU.

CAR MAINTENANCE

- All key S5000 parts are single-brand and thus cost-controlled. Full GRM parts service is available at all events, thus extensive parts stock is not required
- If you choose to own your car, scheduled engine/gearbox maintenance is carried out by S5000's contracted suppliers.

The incentivised series entry fee will be invoiced and paid at the beginning of the 2023 Championship. This fee can be paid over seven instalments as follows:

Round by round entry fees will be invoiced and paid prior to each round.

Entries must be lodged with S5000 Category Management (CM) via the Series Registration and Series Entry Form. Forms are available on request from CM.
