

# VAILO Adelaide 500 23-26 November 2023 Motorsport Australia Permit 823/2611/01 Further Supplementary Regulations for Support Race Categories

To be read in conjunction with all other regulations issued for the Event.

#### 3) DRIVERS' BRIEFING

Attendance is compulsory and failure to **sign on** and be present for the duration of the Drivers Briefing will result in a penalty as per the Circuit Race Standing Regulations (CRSR) unless varied by the Stewards in exceptional circumstances. Team Managers shall also attend if required by Category Sporting Regulations.

#### 4) START PROCEDURES

Races will follow the start procedure as detailed in the relevant Category Sporting Regulations and any other Instructions issued.

#### 5) PIT LANE

- (a) Any person entering the pit lane must display the **appropriate pass** & have completed a Motorsport Australia disclaimer.
- (b) Crews may only remain in pit lane during and immediately prior to their competing Automobile's session/race.
  Crews and equipment must vacate pit lane promptly at the conclusion of their session/race.
- (c) No person under the age of 16yrs (except Drivers competing in the relevant session) will be permitted in the Pit Lane while competition cars are on the Track.
- (d) No equipment may be placed on or be attached to the Pit Wall.
- (e) A speed limit of 40km/h will apply in Pit Lane at all times. If this limit is exceeded, a penalty as per the Circuit Race Standing Regulations will be applied.
- (f) For the sole purpose of aligning their Automobile in its grid position prior to the Start Signal, 1 pit crew member per Automobile is permitted in the signalling wall area during the formation lap and must leave as soon as it is aligned. Up to 3 pit crew members from each Automobile continuing in the Competition will be permitted in the signalling wall area after the Start signal.

#### 6) PADDOCKS

(a) Feature Race Paddock #1 - GT World Challenge Australia (GTWCA), Touring Car Masters, Porsche Carrera Cup Entrance to this Paddock is through Gate 4, which is situated at the corner of Wakefield and Hutt Street, Adelaide. The Paddock is located on the PAC & CBC Ovals adjacent to Wakefield Road, between Turns 3 and 10.

Vehicle access to this Paddock for those vehicles credentialed with a tender pass and approved to remain during the Event is only possible at the following times:

**NOTE:** The circuit will be closed to all traffic on Wednesday 22nd November between 0900hrs and 1315hrs (ACDT) due to a promotional activation on the Circuit (Track Day).

Wednesday	22 November	from 0700 until 0830 and 1315 until 2000 hrs
Thursday	23 November	from 0500 until 0700 hrs
Friday	24 November	from 0500 until 0700 hrs
Saturday	25 November	from 0500 until 0700 hrs
Sunday	26 November	from 0500 until 0700 hrs

After these morning times each day, no general vehicle access through to the Paddock is permitted. The Tunnel cannot be used except in exceptional circumstances. Competitors with an urgent access problem should direct their enquiries to the Race Administration office.

On initial entry to the Paddock, teams may establish themselves only in the space allocated by the Category Manager and the Paddock Officials and must use only this space for the remainder of the Event, unless directed otherwise by Officials.

Once in the Paddock, vehicles may only leave the area via Gate 4 after all Circuit activity has finished for the day & pedestrian traffic has reduced.

This is after approximately: Thursday 1815 hrs Friday: 1800 hrs. Saturday: 1700 hrs.

Sunday bump out: Race Paddock #1(PCCA, GTWCA & TCM)

Due to the Support Paddocks having a high volume of general public pass through and with the public movement to concerts on the Sunday evening, teams may not move from their allocated Support Paddock position on Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> November until the below time and must be managed by Category Managers along with Paddock Marshals. Bump out will be from 1800 hrs (6:30pm) through Gate 4 on Wakefield Rd.

Vehicle access will be permitted only for tender vehicles with the correct tender vehicle pass attached to the inside of the windscreen.

Competitors should note that the public has been invited into the Paddock during times when there is activity on the Track, and the teams should make appropriate arrangements for the security of their team areas.

#### (b) Feature Race Paddock #2 - S5000 Australian Drivers Championship V8 SuperUtes & Dunlop Series.

Entrance for Transporters to this Paddock is from Support Paddock #3 Gate near to General Public Gate 10 on Fullarton Road.

Vehicle access to this Paddock is available on: Tuesday 21 November 0700-1830hrs. Wednesday 22 November 0900-2000hrs. On initial entry to the Paddock, teams may establish themselves only in the space allocated by the Category Manager and the Paddock Officials and must use only this space for the remainder of the Event, unless directed otherwise by the Officials.

No tender vehicles will be permitted in Paddock #2.

#### Sunday bump out Race Paddock #2 (Dunlop Series V8 SuperUtes& S5000)

There will be a Bump Out window during the Supercars race between 1430 & 1630. Once the Supercar race has finished Bump Out can resume at 1800. Exit will be through the Support Paddock 2 Gate on Fullarton Rd (opposite the Dunlop Series marquee). Strictly no transporters can move until Category Mangers are given permission to do so from Event Management.

Competitors should note that the public has been invited into the Paddock during times when there is activity on the track, and the teams should make appropriate arrangements for the security of their team areas.

### 7) RACE TRACK WALK

Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Wednesday 22 November 2022 between **1415hrs** and **1715hrs (ACDT).** Participants shall wear hi-vis vest or shirt.

#### 8) FUEL

Fuel as per the relevant category regulations will be available at the circuit; payment shall be as agreed with the supplier. All Competitors shall only use the fuel on sale by the on course supplier (RaceFuels)

#### 9) MARSHALLING AREA

When teams are called to the Marshalling Area, the race car must be taken there promptly. Any vehicle not in the Marshalling Area prior to the cars being released to the circuit may not be able to join that session or race.

#### 10) FROM MARSHALLING AREA TO PIT LANE, AND GRID

For practice & qualifying sessions Race cars will depart the Marshalling Area and join the circuit in the order in which they have been marshalled. For races, they will be gridded into race start order in the Marshalling Area prior to moving onto the Grid.

No promotional persons, flags or banners may be on the grid without the specific permission of the Promoter. Pit Crew with the appropriate 'Competitor' credentials may walk from the Paddock to Pit Lane prior to their session on the Track.

#### (a) GTWCA, Touring Car Masters, Porsche Carerra Cup, (Paddock 1)

Each category located in Race Paddock 1 will be permitted to use one (1) tender vehicle for every two (2) race cars, to transport equipment to & from Pit Lane for each session. Each tender vehicle must be road registered (no golf buggies, etc) & be no higher/taller than 2m at the highest point (including roof racks, snorkels, aerials, etc). Each tender vehicle must be clearly labelled with the category ID (i.e. GTWCA, TCM or PCCA) & the corresponding race car numbers.

#### (b) S5000, V8 SuperUtes & Dunlop Series (Paddock 2).

No Tender Vehicles are permitted. Pushable Trolleys are allowed to be pushed to Pit Lane for category session via the marshalling gate at Turn 14. These must be pushed (cannot be towed by golf buggy).

#### **11) STARTING GRIDS**

Grid determination will be in accordance with the relevant Category Sporting Regulations.

For each Category, the Organiser reserves the right to include cars which have not achieved the category qualifying criteria in accordance with the Circuit Race Standing Regulations, subject to the approval of the Stewards.

#### 12) END OF EACH SESSION ON THE TRACK

Practice and qualifying sessions which have been interrupted by the showing of a red flag will not be extended except in exceptional circumstances.

GTWCA, Touring Car Masters & Porsche Carrera Cup: At the end of each session or race and after being shown the chequered flag, Drivers will proceed around the track on a full cool down lap and will be directed into their Paddock at Turn 3.

S5000, SuperUtes (& Dunlop Series): At the end of each session or race and after being shown the chequered flag, Drivers will proceed around the Track to Paddock #2 entry/exit at approx. Turn 14 DL where they will be directed into their paddock.

For races, where presentations are applicable, the relevant placegetters will be directed to pit lane for presentations. When the presentations are completed, they will return to the Paddock.

A crew member should remain with the car during presentations who can drive the car back to the Paddock upon direction of the Clerk of the Course.

#### **13) ADDITIONAL SIGNALING POINT**

In addition to the flags shown at the Control Line, the following flag signals may be displayed from Turn 10 on driver's right: The Black flag and the Black Flag with Orange Disc.

#### **14) FIRE EXTINGUISHERS IN GARAGES**

Competitors are reminded of the CRSR requirement for Fire Extinguishers in Garages/Paddock.

The Competitor **must** provide at least 1 certified and fully functioning 4.5kg fire extinguisher compliant with the local legislation in each of their Automobile's Pit Garage or designated paddock area.

#### **15) PADDOCK RULES OF BEHAVIOUR**

We have been afforded the privilege of using the Adelaide Parklands for a motor race event. We will be under observation to ensure that we do not jeopardise the use of the Park and the environment in general.

As a guide to the behaviour expected of us,

- No trees may be damaged by users of the area accidental damage must be reported to the Chief Paddock Marshal as soon as possible.
- The ground surface and grassed areas must not be damaged by users of the area again, any accidental damage must be reported to the Chief Paddock Marshal.
- No barbeques are permitted in any team garages or marquees.
- No fires may be lit at the Circuit.
- All rubbish and refuse (including fuels and other contaminants) are to be disposed of in the bin/drums provided.
- All materials and equipment shall be used & stored so as to prevent damage to the site and minimize hazards to persons, materials and equipment.
- Camping in the parklands is prohibited.
- A Speed limit of **9km/h** applies to all vehicle movements in and around the Paddock.

Competitors should remember that they are ultimately responsible for the actions of all their team and should brief their team accordingly.

#### 16) LIVE STREAMING

At no time during the Event may any form of live streaming from vehicles to any form of social media occur without the express permission of the Promoters.

#### 17) SMOKING

Smoking is specifically prohibited in the Paddocks & Pit Lane areas, this includes E-Cigarettes & similar devices. Smoking is also not permitted in various other areas in the venue.
