**ACCREDITATION** Each entry will receive 7 x accreditation passes | 1 x parking pass. See event overview map for exact location.

I will pass on accreditation and parking passes to each team once all documentation (Team Induction, Self-Scrutiny, MA Disclaimer) has been filled-in and received by Wednesday afternoon. Please don't leave the track without collecting it.

**BUMP IN** S5000 team transporters are permitted to park up from Tuesday, 21<sup>st</sup> November (7:00 – 18:30) or Wednesday, 22<sup>nd</sup> November (9:00 – 20:00). Access will be via Fullarton Road – please call me prior to arriving.

**BUMP OUT** Transporters must stay stationary until approximately 14:30 – 16:30 on Sunday, 26<sup>th</sup> Nov. Exit point will be the same as entry point.

**DOCUMENT CHECK** All licences have been checked prior to the race meeting. All competitors must carry their valid Motorsport Australia licence & club membership card and present it to Motorsport Australia officials if requested.

**DRIVERS BRIEFING** The compulsory Drivers Briefing will be held on **Thursday**, **23<sup>rd</sup> Nov at 7:30am** in the S5000 Paddock.

DSA Alex Davison will be the Driving Standards Advisor.

**FORM UP** will be through the main marshalling area located at DL (Turn 14) on the transit road. Cars will be called in garage order for practice 1 and all subsequent sessions in results order.

FUEL is supplied by Race Fuels; the onsite contact is Brian Franken - 0410 307 769

GARAGES Marque allocations will be available on the S5000 Team Centre.

**PADDOCK MOVEMENTS** A basic paddock movement diagram has been provided to team managers. Please refer to items 10 and 12 in the Further Supplementary Regulations for pre/post-session instructions on returning to the S5000 paddock. This will also be communicated over RMC. *Could teams please make an effort to place themselves towards the pit entry end of the Pit Lane for quick movements after our sessions.* 

**PARKING** Each entry will receive 1 x car park pass – Car Park A with access via East Terrace.

**PARC FERME** Will be confirmed by the S5000 Technical Delegate Frank Adamson. Technical /scales will be located on the roadway adjacent to the S5000 marques.

**PIT LANE DISCLAIMERS** All new personnel will need to complete the Motorsport Australia Disclaimer and return to me prior to the first on-track session.

**PODIUM** arrangements will be confirmed by Team App prior to the final race on Sunday morning.

PUSH TO PASS 40 seconds at 90% throttle

RACE DIRFECTOR Matt Balcombe will be the S5000 Race Director.

**RACE MANAGEMENT CHANNEL (RMC)** It is mandatory for all teams to be tuned into the RMC during all sessions.

Frequency: <u>471.750 tone: 156.7</u> \*This is a listen only channel.

**REQUEST FOR INVESTIGATION FORM** is available if you require an investigation following a session. These must be filled by Team Managers and returned to Category Management no later than 30 minutes after the session requiring investigation. These forms are available at the track. They are also available digitally on Team App. Note: investigations by the Race Director will occur as normal for any incidents that are witnessed in session.

**SERIES STICKERS** are required to be in place before Practice 1. Please see Lisa if you are missing a compulsory sticker. *Please note it is now compulsory for all teams to run the provided Motorsport Australia logo as detailed in the updated decal placement guide.* 

**TEAM APP** It is compulsory for all teams to have at least one team member registered on the app. Stack Team App can be downloaded from the App Store or Google Play. When downloaded you just need to register for the system and can then search for the team to join. Our Team is **'S5000'** 

Team App will be used for quick distribution of team alerts, information and document sharing for the duration of the event, so it is imperative all teams have access.

All event information will also be available on Sportity App (password: ADL500)

**TENDER VEHICLES** Motorised golf buggies are not permitted during the event. Please refer to **item 10(b)** in the Further Supplementary Regulations about the use of service vehicles / trolleys. Permission for trolleys to cross the circuit & enter Pit Lane will be given over RMC.

TRACK WALK The track walk window is from 14:15 – 17:15 on Wednesday, 22<sup>nd</sup> Nov.

High-visibility vests are required - cars, buggies or any other motor vehicles are not permitted.

**TYRES** The Hoosier Tyre truck will be at this event – The Hoosier truck will be located in the S5000 Paddock.

**TYRE WARMING TENTS** Tyre warming tents will NOT be in use at this event.
